## We can trust God... because God keeps his promises.

If you've ever had someone not keep a pinky promise, you know the truth: Some promises aren't worth much. People *mean* to keep their promises, but sometimes it just doesn't happen.

A promise is only as good as who makes it, and God's promises can be trusted! God has kept his promises no matter what. He's never fumbled or forgotten a promise. A long time ago, God promised to send a Rescuer to save people from their sins. He kept that promise when he sent his only Son and our friend, Jesus.

And here's good news: God has made promises to *you!*

Jesus promised to love his friends. To give them peace and joy. And to never, ever forget them.

You can trust Jesus to keep his promises...every promise, every time!

Find out more about those promises God made to his friends by reading these passages: 1 John 4:16; Matthew 28:20; and Romans 15:13.




# Make a seat to take home.

Fold a "sofa"


..and let your

## Here's how:


- 1 Fold the paper in half as shown.




- 2 Fold the paper in half again as shown.




- 3 Unfold, and then fold one side to the center as shown.




- 4 Fold the other side to the center as shown.




- 5 Tuck the corners down on each side to make triangles.



- 6 Fold the middle flap up about an inch from the top.



- 7 Fold in the sides again.



- 8 Pull the middle flap down to create a bench seat. Voila! You've got a sofa!
